



2011/12 League Rule Amendments



RULE 2:

[Reworded] Annual subscription now shown as two prices dependent upon competitive or not

RULE 4:

[Reworded] Section stating age rep as part of committee removed as they will no longer be required.

RULE 5:

(H) All fines and charges shall be paid within 21 days [amended from 14 days] of the date of posting of the written notification. *.(now 21 rather than 14)*

Clubs, Officials or individuals committing a breach of this Rule will be fined a further £10 , failure to pay the original sum and additional fee within a further 7 days will incur an additional fine of £20, failure to pay the original and additional sums within 7 days will result in a third and final fine of £40 being issued. Failure to pay the original and all additional sums within a further 7 day period will result in the offending club being called before a League Disciplinary Committee who will have the power to eject the individual, team or club involved from the league and/or penalise further at the discretion of the Management Committee.

RULE 8:

No player shall be transferred more than twice in the current season in the competitive age groups (U11's – U17's).

(E) (i) None competitive age group teams (U7s, U8s, U9s & U10s) are exempt from the above by way of the following.

[Where a club has two teams in one age group (non-competitive age groups only) players that are registered may play for either team ON SEPARATE FIXTURE DATES ONLY. E.g Player XX can play for the red team on week 1 and the same player may play for the blue team on week 2 BUT CANNOT PLAY FOR BOTH TEAMS ON ANY ONE MATCHDAY. Once the player has participated in any cup/plate competition for one team or the other that player can then only play in the cup/plate competition for that team and cannot transfer to the other team ADDED]

(F) A player may not be transferred to another Club in the Competition after 1st March, in the playing season, except by special permission of the Management Committee.

(F) (i) A player may not be registered for a Club in the Competition after 31st March, in the playing season, except by special permission of the Management Committee.



RULE 11:

The games involving Under 8's, 9's and 10's shall be played over two halves of **15 minutes each half**.

Under 11's matches will be played over two halves consisting of **30 minutes per half**.

Under 12's, 13's, 14's matches shall be played over two halves consisting of 35 minutes a half.

Under 15's, 16's matches shall be played over two halves consisting of **40 minutes a half**.

[Under 17's matches shall be played over two halves consisting of **45 minutes a half**.

Under 17's matches may be played on either the Saturday or the Sunday of the weekend of the match or midweek under floodlights Added]

Postponements due to unfit pitches must be notified by a 9.30 AM [or a minimum of 1 hour prior to kick off whichever is the sooner **ADDED**] deadline to the League Secretary, Referee and opposition if not present; otherwise a fine of £5 will be imposed.

RULE 12:

[(D) All managers are responsible for submitting their own matchday forms **ADDED]**

RULE 14:

[Reworded] B) In cases where there is no officially appointed Referee, the Clubs shall agree upon a Referee. A Referee thus agreed upon shall, for that game, have the full powers, status and authority of a registered Referee. **[Where no official referee is appointed or in attendance, the Exeter & District Youth League will fully support an individual whether a qualified referee or not, who agrees to officiate a mini-soccer fixture or competitive age group fixture. Such an individual should usually officiate the entire match. Any abuse of any matchday official qualified or not, will be taken extremely seriously by the Exeter & District Youth League Committee and each incident will be passed on to Devon County FA. Added]**
